#### **BULKY WASTE - RAEE**

Before disposing of waste, it is necessary, under penalty of sanctions, to arrange for waste collection by agreeing to one of the following methods:

- 1. Call the toll-free number **800 135 221** from Monday to Friday, between 9:00AM and 12:00 noon, or contact the **Ecopoint**
- 2. Fill out the form on the internet portal at **https://comune.amalfi.sa.it/ritiro-raee**

Deposit waste near your residence, at road level, on the agreed day and time, after arranging with the operator.

Depositing bulky waste in Piazza Duomo, Via Lorenzo d'Amalfi, and surrounding areas is strictly prohibited.


## GUEST HOUSES AND RENTED APARTMENTS

Winter: november 1st - march 31st Summer: april 1st - october 31st WASTE DISPOSAL TIMING

Winter: from 10:00 p.m. to 11:55 p.m. Summer: from 11:55 p.m. to 02:00 a.m.

#### WE REMIND YOU TO

- The Respect the waste disposal timing.
- Commit the GLASS in the containers placed along the historic center on the days of multimaterial disposal.
- Commit the FOOD/ORGANIC waste in the bins provided by the Town Council. It is forbidden to hang the bags on the outside walls.
- Commit the PAPER AND CARDBOARD typology without food leftovers and flattened to reduce its volume.
- ☐ Batteries and medicines must be delivered to collection points available in town
- ✓ It is absolutely forbidden to use black bags.
- Commit the USED and OLD CLOTHES inside the containers available in town.
- Commit the exhausted VEGETABLE OILS in the specific containers available in town, or at the ecopoints located in Piazza Spirito Santo and Piazza Municipio on the first Tuesday of each month from 09:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.



# HOW TO RECYCLE CORRECTLY







#### **FOOD/ORGANIC**

All food waste with animal and plant origin, extinguished ashes of fireplaces, greasy paper napkins, used absorbent paper towels, feathers, sawdust, domestic flowers and plants (landless e without vase), and so on.



## NON-RECYCLABLE / DRY ITEMS

Not recyclable plastic and rubber items (not including PE, PET, PVC, PP), all paper types: carbon, greaseproof, baking, laminated, glazed, diapers and pads, vacuum cleaner bags, small wooden painted objects, synthetic sponges, dirty rags, toys (non-electric or electronics). CDs. DVDs. audio and video cassettes, plastic cutlery, shards of vase and porcelain, butts of cigarettes, pens, combs, stockings, cosmetics, toothbrushes, light bulbs, votive lights, small vases of plants, pizza boxes only if greased.



#### MULTIMATERIAL -PLASTIC, METAL AND GLASS

Jars of yogurt, bottles of water, soft drinks and detergents, tanks for liquids, strapping parcel strings, blister packs, cellophane, polystyrene (not greasy) and containers with the symbols PET - PVC - PE - PP - PS.

Boxes and cans in tinplate and metal, all thoroughly washed.

Aluminum containers for food, aluminum foil, empty spray cans (cream, deodorant, hair spray).



#### **GLASS**

Even in different colors and shapes it always is recyclable. The bottles must be committed without cork. The glass objects which are bulky or broken (eg. demijohns, or large slabs) must be committed as "Bulky" waste, upon reservation with the operator.

## PAPER AND CARDBOARD

They are always recyclable, including carton containers for food. The only exception are the "wax papers" or the sheets with strong prevalence of plastic or similar.





## BATTERIES, TONER AND MEDICINES

**Medicines**: pills, syrups, creams and any other expired drug, syringes with protected needles.

#### Cells and batteries:

alkaline batteries, mobile-phone batteries and all the types of batteries you use at home.

#### **Toners and Cartridges:**

Toner and printer cartridges for laser and inkjet printers, tapes for dot matrix printers.







#### **BULKY WASTE**

All bulky household waste (e.g. sofas, mattresses, etc.).

#### R.A.E.E.

All household electrical and electronic equipment (printers, hair dryers, cell phones, TVs / monitors, refrigerators, etc...)
